COVID-19 Update

Unfortunately, we have had confirmed cases of COVID-19 within the school this week. These have all been confined to 1 bubble. Contact has been made with parents of all pupils who have been directly or indirectly affected and this whole bubble has been closed since Monday. We have been in regular contact with the local Public Health Board who are satisfied with all the measures we have in place. The school is shut today to allow a deep clean and fogging to take place. This is being done as a precautionary measure. Remote learning will be set for all pupils who are not in school so please remember to check EFL.

If your child or anyone in your household develops symptoms of COVID-19, they should arrange a test as soon possible. They should not leave home for any reason other than for the test. If the test is positive, they must remain at home for at least 10 days from the date when their symptoms appeared. All other household members who remain well must stay at home and not leave the house for 14 days.
