## Covid 19

As you will be aware, unfortunately, we have had confirmed Covid cases in the school. We have reported these to Public Health England, as per Government guidelines, and we have implemented all the precautionary measures they recommended. These will remain in place for the remainder of this term. Currently, the positive cases are isolated to one specific class and all parents/carers have been notified personally. We are doing everything we possibly can to contain the outbreak and prevent it spreading to the wider school community. In addition to the measures implemented in school PHE emphasised that the most effective measure to manage Covid remains regular testing, and people taking up the offer of a vaccination. We encourage you to continue twice weekly testing. If your child cannot tolerate a lateral flow test, we ask that a parent/carer take it instead –this is to protect all members of our school community. If your child tests positive, please inform the school.
