Covid 19

As you are aware, due to positive cases within the school, we have implemented additional measures this half term to protect both pupils and staff, and I am pleased to say all outbreaks have been contained quickly. At this moment in time, we do not know what changes may be brought in by the Government over the next week. We adhere strictly to DfE guidance in all decisions made and will update you when we have more information after the half term break. As things stand now, we would like to remind you that anyone who is displaying any symptoms, many of which are similar to that of a common cold, should take a lateral flow test. In addition, anyone who has been identified as a close contact, including those with a positive household member, should take a daily LFT for 7 days. This should be done, and a negative result achieved, before the student attends school each day. In addition, twice weekly testing is recommended for all secondary aged pupils. We can supply students with nasal only swabs on request, as for many these are far less invasive. Thank you for your continued support.
