Unfortunately, we have had an increasing number of positive tests within school over the past fortnight. Parents/ Carers of any classes directly affected are always notified at the time that the case is confirmed.

All of our classes require a high number of staff to ensure pupil needs can be safely met, and if we have a high number of staff off in any one class we may have no choice but to close that class and revert to remote learning. We cannot predict absences so this will be assessed on a day by day basis. We appreciate the inconvenience this may cause; however, the health, safety and wellbeing of our pupils will be the top priority in all decisions made.

We continue to encourage parents to continue to undertake twice weekly lateral flow tests as a precaution. Please note that symptoms for current variants are similar to that of a common cold and can include: a runny nose, headache, fatigue (mild or severe), sneezing and /or a sore throat. We kindly request that you test your child if they are displaying any of the above symptoms and if they test positive, that they isolate in line with current Government guidance.
