Covid 19

Unfortunately, we still have a high number of positive cases within the school. Parents/ Carers of any classes directly affected are always notified at the time that the case is confirmed.

We are doing everything we can to keep the school open and running as usual. All of our classes require a high number of staff to ensure pupil needs can be safely met, and if we have a high number of staff off in any one class, we may have no choice but to close that class and revert to remote learning. We cannot predict absences so this will be assessed on a day-by-day basis. We appreciate the inconvenience this may cause; however, the health, safety and wellbeing of our pupils will be the top priority in all decisions made.

We continue to encourage parents to continue to undertake twice weekly lateral flow tests as a precaution.
