Around school this week

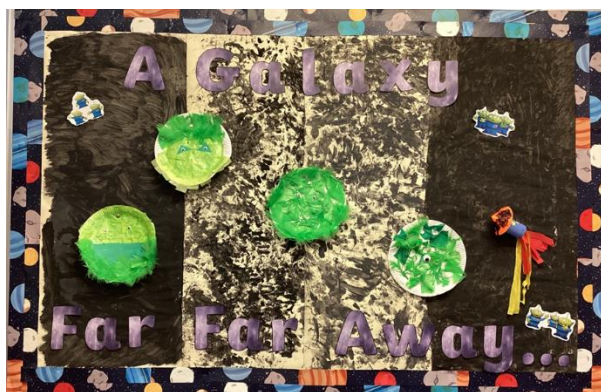
Hamilton created their own magnificent road safety lollipop to help with their road safety practice.



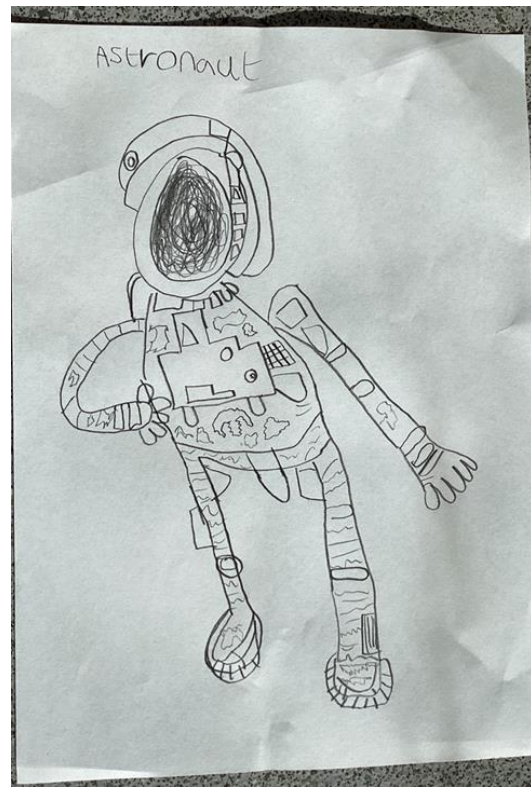
Our pupils met as part of the student council group. They have already created a Student Voice – new School Council board
